  - -Infrastructure with electricity is a challenge. Amy is working on. Cost can be 0-\$5,000. Waiting on the estimate from a contractor.
  - -Gary and Steve Hollingsworth working on Wifi network structure. Estimated cost: \$1.700.
  - -Assisted listening device needs upgrading. Gary and Jon Littlefield working on.
  - -Audio system in the sanctuary needs to be upgraded. They are working on that. Package of equipment to upgrade is about \$6,400.
  - -Streaming services: Need a system that can capture service with both quality video and sound. Gary has presented various systems for consideration. Option he proposes: consumer grade camera, switching station, etc.... Cost about \$3,200-\$3,300.
  - -Improving quality of RE video related offerings: Cost about \$1,000 per room. RE Committee is okay with just having one room set up for zoom.
